

Solis Charter Group Covid Policy 2021

With the Greek government leading the way in limiting the spread of this tragic virus, it has put Solis Charter Group in a great position to offer guests a safe sailing holiday for the 2021 season. We are working hard to constantly revise and create new policies and measures to ensure the safety and wellbeing of our customers and staff.

Solis Charter Group is focused on staying up to date with the latest Greek authority regulations, as well as the World Health Organization (WHO) and ECDC, therefore our policies are constantly being updated.

The following information is intended to inform you of what is required and recommended of the guests, skipper and crew due to Covid-19 while on holiday in Greece.

Solis Staff -

- All staff members will be temperature and pulse checked every day before starting work
- All staff will strictly adhere to social distancing rules (1.5 meters apart by law)
- All staff will wear the appropriate PPE when in contact with guests and other staff members
- Strict handwashing and sanitation procedures have been implemented around the workplace and on the boats.
- Our staff have received extra training to help minimise Covid-19 risk and provide the correct up to date information to guests including health care facilities on different islands

Charterers/Crew -

- All guests must have completed and returned the pre-arrival health declaration form <https://gr.usembassy.gov/wp-content/uploads/sites/206/form-in-english-for-greek-island-ferries.pdf> before you arrive in Greece
- Only the lead booking name and Skipper will be allowed on the yacht during the check-in.

Yacht Cleaning and Equipment -

- Solis Charter Group is following the guidelines set out by the Greek Government and will comply with any direction given by the authorities. Your yacht will be cleaned, sanitized and prepared with inventory check before arrival. The initial sanitizing takes place once the previous clients have left the yacht
- A temperature checking device and finger pulse checker will be provided on all boats
- The bed linen will be in a sealed bag for you to make up the beds

Charter Rescheduling & Cancellation Policy

In the event that travel restrictions are in place and the charterer is unable to make the scheduled charter date/destination, due to Covid-19 related circumstances, we offer the possibility of rescheduling the charter to a future date within 12 months of the original charter, or issue a credit note for any deposit paid, which can be used against any future charter with Solis Charter Group.

This policy is available with notice of at least 15 days prior to the original scheduled charter. All charters are evaluated on a case by case basis.
