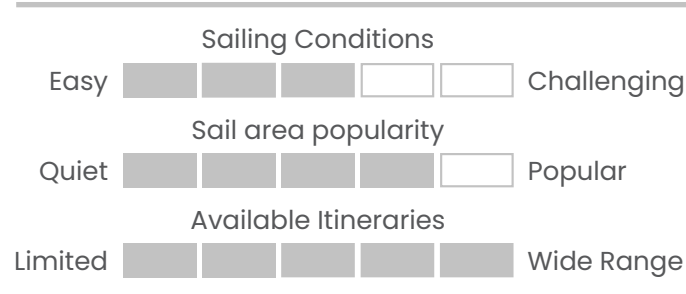

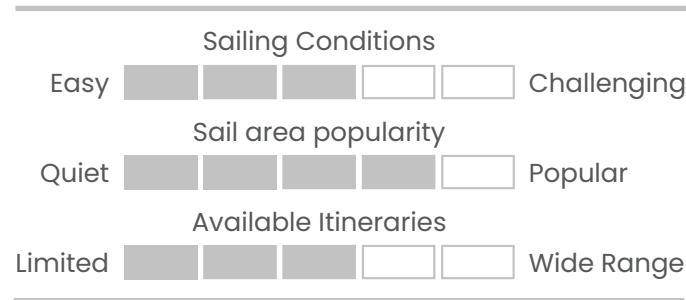
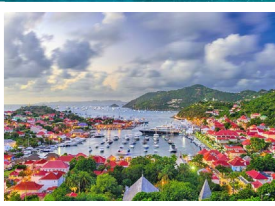
British Virgin Islands

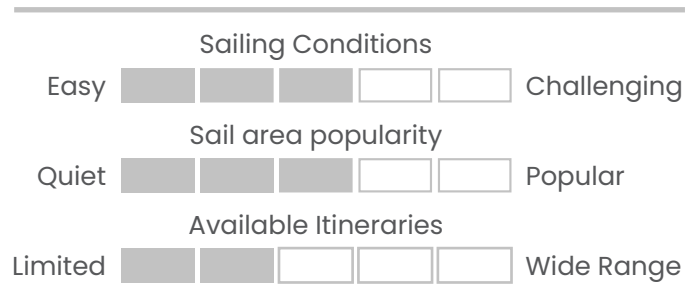
