The Ionian sets itself apart with consistently perfect sailing conditions in sheltered seas. You will find innumerable safe anchorages with lush green surrounds. Its a perfect destination for fun & relaxed sailing holidays.

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Paxos - Considering the comparatively small size of the Island, Paxos has a whole lot to offer! The island has an air of sophistication and elegance which is quite charming to behold. The Western coastline is characterised by tall white cliffs that rise straight out of the sea with some spectacular anchorages nestled between. There are three main villages on the island; Gaios, Lakka and Longos. Each village is characterised by charming pastel coloured waterfronts but explore a little deeper and you'll find yourself lost in a maze of delightful narrow back-roads.

Just to the South of Paxos is the islet of Antipaxos and here, like on the larger island, you will find amazing clear waters and a number of picturesque anchorages.
